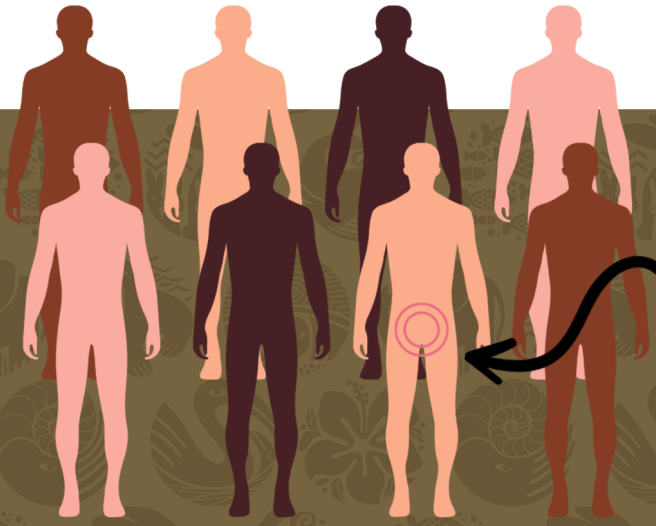
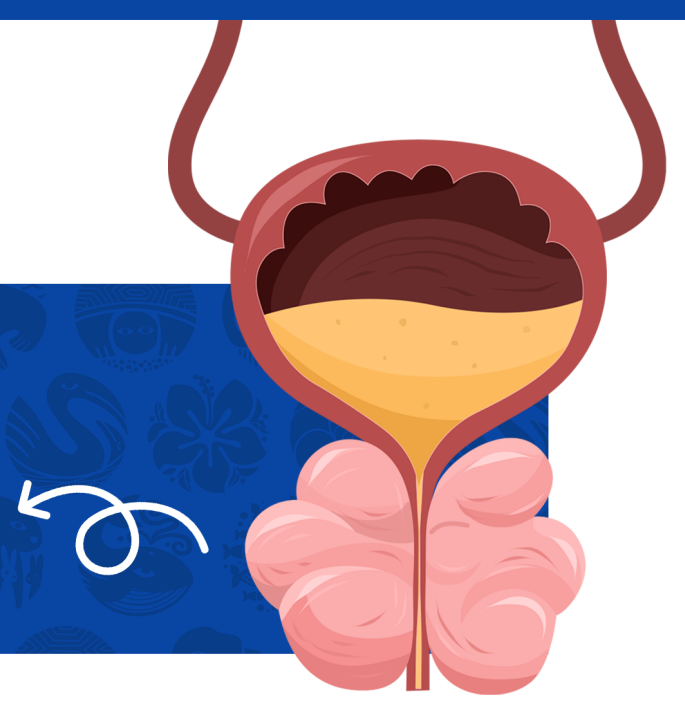


Men's Health: Let's Talk About **PROSTATE CANCER**



1 in 8 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer in their lifetime.
30% of all male cancer diagnoses are prostate cancer. It is the most common cancer among men in the United States.

Fewer than half of men in the prime screening ages of 55 to 69 have had a PSA test in the past two years.

Most men who do get tested say their doctor brought it up first.



Nearly 100% is the five-year survival rate when prostate cancer is caught before it spreads. When it isn't caught early, that number drops sharply.

The American Cancer Society recommends all men talk to their provider about prostate cancer screening starting at age 50.

If you have a family history of prostate cancer, that conversation should start sooner.
